

## **JUDGES ASSISTANTS DUTIES**

1. Introduce yourself to the judge and explain that you will assist them in any way they request.
2. Check periodically with judges to see if they need a break or refreshments.
3. Try at all times to keep the event moving.
4. Make sure the 4-Her knows how to use the easel, and assist the 4-Her if help is necessary. (Different height adjustments)  
Help hold posters if they fall down, etc.
5. Close and guard the door so nobody interrupts the 4-Her while they are presenting.
6. Open the door after the speaker is finished so the public understands they can enter.
