

## 4-H Club Seal Optional Activities

- \_\_\_1. A majority of the officers receive officer training.
- \_\_\_2. Members participate in two or more sections of the county 4-H Day excluding Model Meeting. (Demonstrations/Illustrated Talks, Project, talks, Music, Talent)
- \_\_\_3. Render some service to the community, such as – present program for another organization, assist persons less fortunate, assist with some worthy cause, help in a community enterprise, or in Community Resource Development. Give summary of work done. If more than one community project was done, you may count each.
- \_\_\_4. Plan and present a model meeting at 4-H County Club Day
- \_\_\_5. Have one or more 4-Hers participate in speaking sections at County 4-H Day ie talks, demonstrations, public speaking.
- \_\_\_6. Have one or more entries in Demonstration Day associated with county fair.
- \_\_\_7. Provide three feature stories and/or ten or more news stories, or any combinations thereof, for publication on project work, club meeting, or group projects.
- \_\_\_8. Hold a parent's night Community Club meeting and program
- \_\_\_9. Have an achievement program at a regular or special 4-H Meeting to bring the accomplishments of the 4-Her's to the attention of the people in the area
- \_\_\_10. Hold a club project tour or local community club project fair.
- \_\_\_11. One or more project leaders in the club have "individual 4-Her's evaluation" conference with a majority of the 4-Her's in their group
- \_\_\_12. Maintain or increase from previous year, the number of 4-Hers enrolled in the club
- \_\_\_13. Junior leaders assist project leaders at two or more project meetings
- \_\_\_14. Plan and carry out one or more club projects such as safety, health, conservation of natural resources, (ie Acres for Wildlife, soil / wildlife conservation efforts), recreation, people to people, emergency preparedness, citizenship, ecology, pollution control, or other areas. Give a brief summary of work done. If more than one club project is done, each may be counted.
- \_\_\_15. Present a program to explain and promote 4-H at one or more schools or other public or civic organizations.
- \_\_\_16. Have an exchange meeting or other event with another 4-H group or club in yours or another county.
- \_\_\_17. Present a radio program or have a majority of club members do 4-H week radio spot
- \_\_\_18. Make a contribution to county IFYE fund or another county non-profit fund ie Kansas 4-H Foundation, Cancer, March of Dimes, MS, MD or similar drives

- \_\_\_19. Take a group educational one-day trip or tour
- \_\_\_20. Visit people in rest home and /or provide a program of programs and remembrances for them
- \_\_\_21. Three or more 4-H'ers participate in a county or district 4-H judging school or contest. List names and contest:

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- \_\_\_22. Cooperate with county Extension Agents or the elected 4-H PDC members in organizing a new 4-H club or group.
- \_\_\_23. Have a window display promoting some phase of 4-H during 4-H Week
- \_\_\_24. Have a booth/banner at the county fair
- \_\_\_25. Have a 4-H Float in a community parade.
- \_\_\_26. Attend/Participate in Club 4-H Sunday observance
- \_\_\_27. Have 4-H'ers participate in a county or state camp.
- \_\_\_28. Have 4-H'ers participate in two or more county events not included in any other optional activities/events ie Parade of Purples, Spring Garden & Flower Show, Spring Livestock shows, Favorite Foods or other similar events.
- \_\_\_29. Have exhibits from your club or group at the Kansas State Fair
- \_\_\_30. Have 4-H'ers participate in the Kansas State Fair in ways other than exhibiting project work ie Photo Fun Day, Judging contests, Style Revue
- \_\_\_31. Have one or more 4-H'ers attend a training meeting for camp counselors, camp program assistants, and assist with the day or county camps.
- \_\_\_32. Have a club family serve as a IFYE or LABO delegate host or have a member as an IFYE or LABO delegate.
- \_\_\_33. Provide junior leader assistance at other county events such as Club Day, Style Revue, judging contest, spring shows etc
- \_\_\_34. Provide junior leader or superintendent at the county fair.
- \_\_\_35. Complete a self-determined goal approved by the County Extension Office
- \_\_\_36. Have one or more 4-Hers selected as county 4-H Ambassador
- \_\_\_37. Have one or more 4-H'ers attend Discovery Days or KYLF
- \_\_\_38. Have one or more 4-H'ers participate in conference judging at Kansas State Fair.
- \_\_\_39. Have 4-H'ers Participate in Gavel Games at county Club days
- \_\_\_40. Have qualifying 4-H'ers participate in Regional 4-H Day.
