4-H SUNDAY COMMITTEE

Blue Ribbon

- Meet by March 4-H Council Meeting to brainstorm for ideas and assign jobs and appoint club members to the job committees
- Get program, speaker, music, inspirational music, P.A. System, etc.
- Notify churches (publicity)
- Plan how and which members will participate in the program
- June 4-H Council meeting - report on final plans
- Pull the Fairboard stage to where it's needed if you will use it
- Send out letters of invitation to all churches
- Design poster to be posted in each community
- The 4-H Council will guarantee \$100 if donations are not adequate

First part of July

- Consider contingency plans if it should rain that morning
- Plan for offering during service

4-H SUNDAY AT THE FAIR

- Set up (bleachers, stage, P.A., piano if needed, etc)
- Make sure electricity is available
- Arrange for someone to take offering
- Arrange for someone to meet speaker upon arrival
- Pass out programs
- Clean up!

- Arrive 30 minutes early to set up tables & chairs if needed to decorate
- 4-H Ambassadors will give invocation & commence the ceremony
- 4-H Ambassadors and 4-H Council officers (if needed) will greet, meet & accompany throughout the meal, special guests - speaker, Farm Credit Rep. etc.
