FAIR ENTRY.....

Beginning May 15, 2023, please log on to http://coffeycountyfair.fairentry.com from your computer or any mobile device (including smartphones) to submit your entries to the fair. The online entry system will streamline the entry process so, check-ins, show programs and results can be processed and posted quickly and efficiently at the fair.

Online entries will be required for all exhibitors. The deadline for online entries in the areas of Cloverbuds, Clothing, Demonstrations, all Livestock (including rabbits and poultry), and all pets is June 28, 2023. The deadline for online entries in all other projects is July 12, 2023. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-ENTERED. These deadlines will be strictly enforced since the system will close entries at 11:59 p.m. CT on these dates. Late entries will be assessed a late entry fee. We have attached instructions for the entry process on the next page. If you do not have internet access or need assistance with the entry process, the Extension Office is always available to help you with your entries.

K-State Showcase Veterinary Student Experience with Hands-on Learning

Kansas State University's College of Veterinary Medicine is giving elementary, middle school, high school and college students an opportunity to experience "A Day in the Life of a Veterinary Student" at the 2023 Vet Med ROCKS summer camps.

The series of day camps for youth will take place July 30-August 2, and are hosted by the Vet Med Recruitment and Outreach Club at Kansas State University, or Vet Med ROCKS, a registered departmental student organization in the College of Veterinary Medicine.

This year's theme is "A Day in the Life of a Veterinary Student." Campers will experience a day similar to that of a veterinary student with hands-on activities and learning from College of Veterinary Medicine students and faculty.

Vet Med ROCKS camp is an excellent opportunity for students to explore their interest in the veterinary profession. Led by outstanding students of the K-State College of Veterinary Medicine, the camp is a great way for youth to explore being a veterinary student and a future veterinarian.

July 30 will be a virtual day of presentations and at-home activities for high school and college students. These campers will then attend in person on July 31 for hands-on labs with faculty and vet med student camp counselors throughout the day. August 1 will be an in-person camp for middle school students entering sixth through eighth grades, and August 2 is an in-person camp for grade school students entering the fourth and fifth grades.
