

General Show Rules:

1. This show will be open to all bonafide 4-H or FFA members who are not 19 years of age before January 1 of the current year. Separate entry forms are required for each animal. Entry cards must be filled out before weighing market animals or checking breeding animals in.
2. You must show your own animals, unless you have two in a class.
3. All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the show management nor the Extension Council shall be held responsible for any loss that might arise. All disputes or rule violations will be settled by the Show Management. The Show Management reserves the right to decide any questions that are not covered by these rules.
4. **NO bedding, chips, straw or hay allowed in the barns**
5. Entry fee will be \$10.00 per pre-entered animal, **\$20.00 per animal if not pre-entered**, payable when you pick up entry cards prior to weigh-in. .
6. **Pre-Entry in Extension Office required by April 18th** – Pay at the show.
7. All market animals must be ear tagged with an official 4-H tag
8. Species “general” divisions may be broken into specific breed classes if 4 or more individuals of a particular breed are pre-entered.
9. Classes may be determined at the discretion of the Show Management
10. Prizes awarded to the Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champions

Steer Classes:

1. **This is a prospect show** and will be judged as one. There are no weight limits. No re-weighs. Particular breed splits if 4 or more of a breed are entered
2. Division 1: Purebred English breed steers
Division 2: Purebred Continental breed steers
Division 3: Crossbred Steers
Division 4: Market Heifer

Breeding Heifer Classes:

1. Heifers will show as “Purebred” & “Commercial” with purebred breed splits if 4 or more of a breed are entered.
2. Heifer birth date shall be no earlier than January 1 of previous year.
3. Registration papers in the exhibitor’s name are required, if no papers heifers will show in the commercial class.
Division 5: Purebred Heifers (registration papers required)
Division 6: Commercial Heifers

Lamb Classes:

1. Either wethers or ewes may be shown in the prospect class. No ram lambs will be allowed to show.
2. **This is a prospect show** and will be judged as one. There are no weight limits. No re-weighs. Particular breed splits if 4 or more of a breed are entered
3. Lambs showing active sore mouth lesions or active club lamb fungus will not be allowed to show and will be required to remain in the trailer. Lambs may be examined by a veterinarian for verification.
4. All lambs must have a scrapie ear tag.

Prospect Market Lambs:

1. All market lambs must be slick shorn.
2. Division 1: Black-face lambs
Division 2: White-face lambs
Division 3: Natural
Division 4: Crossbred
3. All market lambs must have a permanent scrapies ear tag
4. Show will be judged as a prospect show. Particular breeds will show separately if 4 or more individuals of a breed are entered

Breeding Ewes:

1. Ewes birth date shall be no earlier than January 1 of previous year
2. Breeds will be separated as “Black-face”, “White-face”, “Commercial”. Particular breeds will show separately if 4 or more individuals of a breed are entered and a prize awarded to the Supreme Ewe

Showmanship Classes: Beef and Sheep

1. Contestants must show their own animals
2. Divisions will be:
Seniors 14 yrs of age and older
Intermediate 10 to 13 years of age
Juniors 7 to 9 years of age
Ages are based on child’s age as of January 1, 2016. Prizes will be awarded to the Champion and the Reserve Champion in each age division.

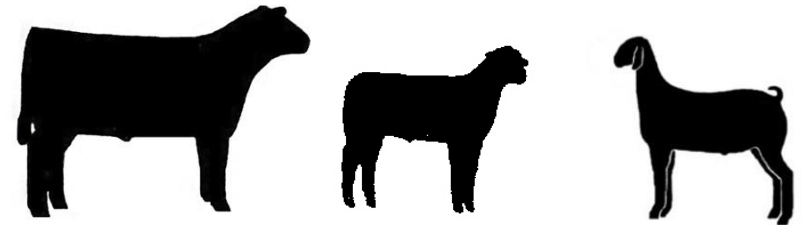

Separate showmanship card is to be filled out and turned in at the scale or check in table. **Entry fee is \$20.00 per animal if animals are NOT PRE-ENTERED.**

Woodson County Shows will be the same day. Verified weights taken in Woodson County and forwarded on will be accepted at check-in for the Coffey County Show.

Coffey County Spring Show Entry 2017 Meat Goat Entry

Meat Goat Classes:

1. Either wethers or does may be shown in the prospect class. No bucks will be allowed to show.
2. This is a prospect show and will be judged as one. There are no weight limits. No re-weighs.
3. Clipping of hair should not exceed 3/8 inch. If shown with horns, they should be at minimum blunted with tip the size of a dime.
4. Bracing of goats **will be** allowed, however **all 4 feet of the goat must contact the ground during judges handling** of the animal
5. All goats must have a scrapie ear tag.

Prospect Market Goats:

1. Prospect goats will be shown all breeds together split by weight
 - Division 1 – 20 to 30 pounds
 - Division 2 – 31 to 40 pounds
 - Division 3 – 41 to 50 pounds
 - Division 4 – Over 50 pounds

Breeding Goats

- Division 1 - Doe kids born after January 1 2016
- Division 2 – Yearling does

Goat Showmanship Classes:

1. Contestants must show their own animals
 2. Divisions will be:
 - Seniors 14 to 18 yrs of age
 - Intermediate 9 to 13 years of age
 - Juniors 7 and 8 years of ageAges are based on 4-Her's age as of January 1, 2016.
