4. Pre-Entries are due by Sunday, May 19, 2024.
5. Pay the day of the show, but pre-entries will have the discounted rate.

Show Rules

1. **Show Age**–Open to 4-H and FFA youth 18 years of age and younger as of January 1, 2024.
2. **Showmanship Ages**– Senior 14-18, Intermediate 10-13, Junior 7-9 Ages are based on child's age as of January 1, 2024. Prizes will be awarded to the Champion and the Reserve Champion in each age division.
3. **Exhibitor must show their own animal**–If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, they may have another exhibitor show the additional animal.
4. **Ear Tags**–All swine are required to have a 4-H ID tag by the day of the show.
5. **Animals shown in market class are not eligible to show in breeding class.** Market swine can be barrows or gilts.

7. No intact males may be shown.

8. Classes will be split based on weight and breed—A breed must have 3 or more animals showing to make a class. Breeds with less than 3 will show in AOB class.

9. Coffey County Spring Swine Show Committee reserves the right to alter/combine classes and make changes. Changes will be announced at the beginning of the show.

10.Pens—No bedding allowed in the pens. You are encouraged to show out of your trailer.

11. No Refunds.

12.All persons who attend or participate do so at their own risk. K-State Research and Extension Coffey County and the Coffey County Fair Association will not be held responsible for any damages to, or losses of property, accidents or loss or injury of animals.

13.Show officials reserve the right to disqualify exhibitors based on issues not covered in show rules.
