Fair Entry

Watch for more information on Fair Entry beginning dates. When Fair Entry is open, log on from your computer or any mobile device (including smartphones) to submit your entries to the fair. The online entry system will streamline the entry process so that check-ins, show programs and results can be processed and posted quickly and efficiently at the fair.

Online entries will be required for all exhibitors.

The deadline for online entries in the following project areas is June 30, 2025:

Cloverbuds, Sewing, Shopping in Style, Fiber Arts, Demonstrations, all Livestock (including rabbits and poultry), and all pets. The deadline for online entries in all other projects is July 14, 2025.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-ENTERED. If you have multiple entries in one project, you MUST enter each entry in the Fair Entry system.

These deadlines will be strictly enforced since the system will close entries at 11:59 p.m. CT on these dates. If you do not have internet access or need assistance with the entry process, the Extension Office is always available to help you with your entries. If you have any questions about the process, feel free to give us a call during regular business hours for assistance. We look forward to streamlining these processes to make your fair experience the best yet!

SAVE THE DATE: Please save the date for **mandatory** pullorum testing on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>June 25th</u> <u>from 5-7 pm at the Fairgrounds.</u> This is <u>required</u> for all 4-H and open-class chickens, turkeys, and game birds regardless of age.
