Ambassadors' Requirements for Application

- 1. Age Requirement: Entering Freshman-Senior year in High School
- 2. 4-H member for at least two years
- 3. Complete the Ambassador Application

Two members per club may be selected each year. Membership ends upon High School graduation.

Requirements of Ambassadors

- 1. Commitment to the Coffey County 4-H Program, including attending at least 10 of your 4-H Club's meetings.
- 2. <u>Positive Attitude</u> about 4-H and all other 4-H'ers
- 3. Proficient communication skills-- Including but not limited to having one's own email address and cell phone; checking and responding to messages in a timely manner.
- 4. Willingness to promote 4-H to the public.
- 5. Willingness to participate in Ambassador functions such as leadership activities and five goals set & agreed upon by the group such as, but not limited to:
 - A. Introduce new families to the 4-H program at a Project Enrollment Fair and be available to answer questions.
 - B. National 4-H week promotion on the radio, delivering table tents to restaurants, taking posters to businesses, sponsoring the window display contest for the clubs, etc.
 - C. Help organize and/or narrate the Achievement Banquet, 4-H Day, Awards Ceremony at the Fair.
 - D. Help organize the "Donor Appreciation" activities in your club.
 - E. Organize, plan, and conduct a Coffey County 4-H Promotional activity.
 - F. Participate in community activities that the ambassador group agrees to participate in.
 - G. Do a community service activity each quarter of the year, including 48 Hours of 4-H during October.
 - H. Serve as an irreproachable representative of the Coffey County 4-H program. Especially when attending out-of-county events.
 - I. Submit a "Record Book" consisting of: a personal page, permanent record, and at least two KAP's with entries in each of its sections to continue being an Ambassador through the following year.
 - J. Presentations to Civic Groups.
 - K. Help promote 4-H information through various media i.e., radio, school newspaper, web posting, social networking.

Attendance Requirements
